I'd like to invite you to attend our 26th Annual sale held at the ranch on January 26, 2026, at 1:26 p.m. or on DV Auction. Com. We will be selling 70 head of long aged coming 2-year-old bulls that have never been pampered or over fed. Bulls that have been bred for performance and doability. Bulls that are easy handling and gentle natured. We have been hard-nosed and unyielding on disposition. We will not tolerate high headed cattle or aggressive behavior. Our cows graze on grass or crop residue for 10 months out of the year, being fed hay and range cake for 2 month or less.

Structural soundness is imperative on our operation as the cows must be able to travel to water and grazing as we run in large pastures with long distances between water sources.

We have limited labor as it is just family, so we expect our cows to calve on their own and get their calves up and going unassisted. We calve out behind tree patches or behind windbreaks. Without calving barns or buildings.

I have always been a big believer in performance and data driven production. We want to see cattle that grow, yield and grade. Cattle must be long spined, long hipped and have adequate body without being wastey in their make-up. Don't look for any "puss-guts" here! Today's trend of "deep made and soft belly draggers" is a yield killer and should be avoided. We have been involved in finishing cattle and selling feeder cattle and we sell more fed cattle and feeders than we do seedstock. For the last 15+ years we have fed to finish and collected feeding data and carcass data. Also, we have been selling beef direct to the consumer for the last 10 years as well.

So, if you want to use no-nonsense real-world cattle then I ask you to join us on January 26.

It was a beautiful bright sunny day at Bullis Creek Ranch on January 27 in the heart of cow country America aka the sandhills of Nebraska. Cattlemen appraised a set of long aged non pampered easy handling gentle bulls with muscle, carcass and bred in maternal for Generations. The Brawner family has raised Limousin for the last 54 years and Red Angus for the last 32 years on a ranch that has been in existence since 1917. Bidding was fast paced and active as buyers selected top genetics for their ranches.

Red Angus Highlights

BCRR Lead Time 331L commanded a top bid of \$14,250 from Allen Red Angus of Ainsworth, NE, who was also the sales' top volume buyer taking home 7 head.

BCRR Monument 327L was the first pick of the pen of Fritz Monument son's to sell going to Roger Lechtenburg of Ainsworth, NE for \$10,000.

BCRR Mr. 3110L a top son of Fritz Monument sold to long-time buyer Gordon Cattle Co of Chinook, MT for \$10,000.

BCRR Momentum 339L the next Monument son picked went home with Ravenscroft Red Angus of Nenzel, NE. He was a full brother to the high selling bull at Bullis Creek in 2023. 339L commanded a bid of \$10,000. The last 2 Monument sons left the ring at \$7,500 and \$6,500 respectively.

Limousin/LimFlex Highlights

BRAW Empize 3237L notched \$8,000 going to Jon Soukup of Lesterville, SD. He was sired by Wulf's Empize who sired last year's top seller.

BRAW WF 3229L went to past Bullis Creek buyers Schmale Farms and Feedlot. This CJS Windfall son was a crowd favorite. He left the ring at \$8,000.

BRAW Defend 3202L sold going to Cindy Doke of Wray, CO. Cindy who also bought several other good herdbulls and last fall bought a large number of females from Bullis Creek at private treaty. 3202 brought \$6,500 and was son of Wulf's Defend who is #10 on Vytelle's top 150 list for feed efficiency.

BRAW Yellowstone 3261L went to past buyers Wulf Cattle of Morris, MN. This son of JBV Yellowstone left the ring at \$6,500. He has a index on the new TPI that is in the top 1% of the breed. We wish all the best to Wulf's with this outstanding herd sire prospect.

NILE MERIT PROGRAM

We donated a Red Angus heifer to the NILE heifer program in Billings, MT. In the past we had been a donor of several heifers but had not donated in recent years. We were contacted by the person in charge of the program that a youth in Nebraska had applied for a Red Angus heifer, but they didn't have a donor and wondered if we would help by donating to the program and give a heifer.

The Merit heifer program was designed to award heifers to youth who apply for a heifer and agree to keep records on the animal such as feed, management and breeding records. Youth is encouraged to show the heifer in local, regional and national shows. The project recipient must give a monthly report and bring the heifer back to the next year's Nile Merit heifer show and compete for breed champion and overall Merit heifer champion as well as the recipients also compete individually. They compete in showmanship and through an interview process.

We donated a Fritz Monument heifer. BCRR Gem Merit 417M-5032825. Her dam was a 3SCC Domain daughter and she represented us well. She was the Champion Red Angus Merit heifer. Congratulations to Madison Engel of Minatare, NE the Merit heifer applicant. Madison did a great job with the heifer, and we would like to thank her for all her hard work and dedication. We have known her family for a long time and would like to wish them all the best and hope that the heifer does great for Madison.

Conveyor's 2-year-old dam is a product of ET and combines several top sire lines for growth, performance and carcass. Conveyor ranks in the top 10% of the breed for 3 economically important traits including being in the top 5% for Mainstream Terminal Index. His gridmaster score is 61 to place him in the top 35% of the breed. Sired by Feddes Treadstone, a top son of 5L Bourne and his dam is an 5L Independence x Deep End combination. When he stepped off the trailer coming from New York the trucker said he had traveled 1998 miles! I think you can see that he is named appropriately!
